In the street/with your host family /with your teachers :

- “respect places, make your bed and tidy your clothes”
- “turn the heat down, air out your bedroom and clean up your room and your things”
- “taste all the things that your family offers”

- “open your eyes, your ears, record vocabulary in your head”
- “write notes in your mobile, look at the advertisements in the street”
- “record a lot of English vocabulary in your head”
